Small and casual, Dominican home cooking—just across the street. No set menu, just whatever the cook prepares that day.

Café 104

39-14 104th Street (between Roosevelt Ave & 39th Ave) 718-651-3778

Serves American and Dominican food. Salads, hot meals, sandwiches, coffee. Plenty of seats. Close to #7 train.
